

CLASS LEVELS

Pre-Ballet Ages 3, 4, & 5, 1 class per week
Beginning Ballet Rising 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd Graders, 1 class per week
Ballet 1 Dancers who have completed 3 rd Grade & up in school, 2 classes per week, Beginning Level
Ballet 2 4 classes per week, (3 technique + 1 additional pre-pointe class per placement by instructor), Beginning Intermediate Level
Ballet 3 6 classes per week required, (4 technique + 2 pointe), Intermediate Level
Ballet 4 6 classes per week required, (4 technique + 2 pointe), Intermediate Level
Ballet 5 – Advanced Ballet 8 classes per week offered, 7 ballet required + 1 jazz or modern minimum), Advanced Levels
Jazz - Beginning Dancers who have completed 2 nd Grade & up in school, or by permission of Instructor, 1 class per week.
Jazz - Intermediate (Ballet 3 + 4, Jazz 2) Placement by Instructor, 1 class per week
Jazz - Advanced (Ballet 5 + Advanced, Jazz 3) Placement by Instructor, 1 class per week
Tap 1 & Tap 2 Age 6+ through rising 4th graders, placement by instructor
Hip Hop Rising 3 rd graders & up in school, or by permission of Instructor, 1 class per week
Modern - Intermediate (Ballet 2 & 3 and Modern 1) Placement by Instructor, 1 class per week
Modern - Advanced (Ballet 4 & 5 – Advanced & Modern 2) Placement by Instructor, 1 class per week
Contemporary - Intermediate 1-2 Open to Ballet 1, 2, & 3 students or by permission of Instructor, 1 class per week
Contemporary - Advanced Open to Ballet 4, 5, & Adv., must be enrolled in Ballet or by permission of Instructor, 1 class per week
Choreography Workshop Open to Ballet 3 and higher, 1 class per week
African Dance Ballet 1 and Up
Adult Ballet Age 18+
Private Classes By appointment

***No dancer may take pointe unless concurrently enrolled in
at least three ballet technique classes per week.**

CLASS PLACEMENT & ATTENDANCE

All beginners are placed according to age. Students with prior dance experience are placed according to ability. The goal of our school is to maintain a high level of excellence in classical ballet training. As a student progresses, more frequent classes are required. Students must take the required number of classes for their level. **Please call the office or email adtdance1@gmail.com when a student must be absent.** Missed classes should be made up promptly.

CLASS ATTIRE

Dance students are expected to be properly attired for each class. Girls' hair must be secured in buns. Jewelry and loose clothing should not be worn in class. Male students should wear white t-shirts, black tights, dance belt, and black shoes. Female students should wear pink or flesh colored tights and ballet slippers and:

Pre-Ballet, Tutus & Tiaras: Ballet pink short sleeve leotard
Beginning Ballet: Light blue short sleeve leotard
Ballet 1, 2, 3 Lilac or black short sleeve leotard
Ballet 3, 4, 5, Advanced Solid color leotard of choice A pink camisole leotard (Mirella 201L recommended) and a matching pink skirt are required for Seminar
Jazz Form-fitting dancewear and black jazz shoes
Tap Form-fitting dance wear and black tap shoes
Hip Hop Clothing that allows freedom of movement, laced tennis shoes or jazz sneakers, soft kneepads
Modern / Contemporary / African Leotard and tights or unitard of choice, bare feet
Adult Ballet Clothing that allows freedom of movement, hair secured, ballet shoes

TUITION

An annual Registration Fee of \$50 per family is payable to the Alabama Dance Theatre. If you have paid a Registration Fee since July 2022, none is owed for the Summer Session. Tuition is due no later than the first class of the Session. We are unable to give refunds. Non-attendance is not considered withdrawal from class. Please submit written notification of withdrawal. Tuition is payable to the Alabama Dance Theatre.

Summer Seminar \$450 two week session Discounted to \$400 if received by June 20, 2023.

Full Summer Tuition Payment is required by June 5. Payment may be split, with half due June 1 and the balance due July 1 - please speak to the office. A late fee of \$30 is added to any tuition not received by the 7th of the month. A discount of \$5 is allowed for each additional family member enrolled. Tuition and all fees must remain current. Student enrollment may be affected if an account is over 30 days past due. Limited Financial Aid Scholarships available; please contact the Artistic Director and submit the Financial Aid Application at least two weeks prior to the beginning of a session. Private Instruction is available.
